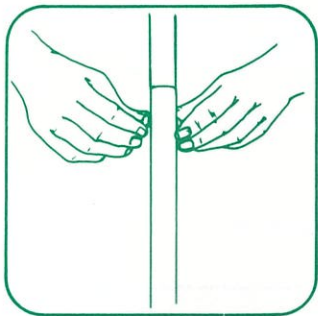




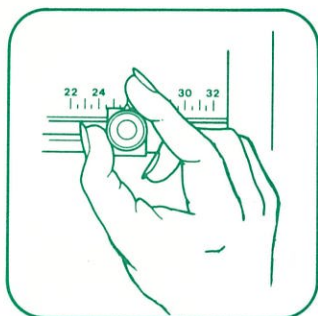
J. Install upper handle with medium bolt and nut. Now tighten *all* nuts with wrench and screwdriver.

K. Slip hand grip on upper handle. (Lubricating the inside of grip with soapy water will allow for easier slippage.) Slip tube cap on leg.

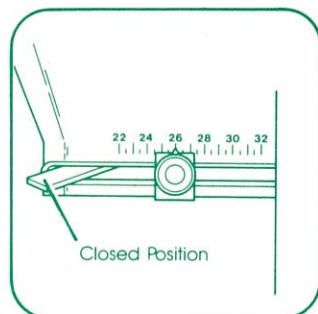
How to use and maintain your spreader

Use

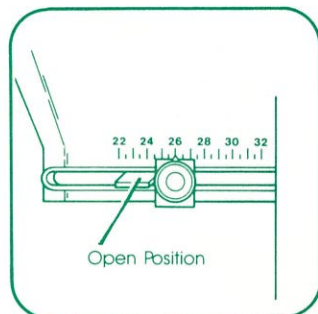
A. Be sure to use the correct spreader setting for the product being applied. The setting appears on most Scotts product packages. If no setting is given on the package, refer to the enclosed list.



B. Loosen knob and slide pointer until it lines up with the number given for the setting. Tighten knob.



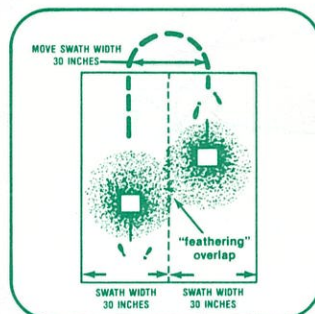
C. Always fill spreader on the walk or driveway — not on the lawn. Move shut-off lever as far left as possible to its closed position. Pour product into hopper.



D. When you're ready to begin, slide shut-off lever to the right so it touches pointer. Then begin walking at a normal pace. Product application automatically starts and stops when you do. Avoid tipping spreader during use.

E. Move shut-off lever to closed position to stop product flow.

Application Tips



A. To avoid misses or striping, make each pass about 30-in. from the previous one so some overlapping does occur. You can do this by checking to see that particles are falling close to the previous tire tracks. For best results, don't apply product on a windy day.



B. For easiest application, apply product the length of the lawn. Apply two header strips across each end for a turning area.



C. If lawn is irregular in shape, apply a header strip completely around it. Then, move back and forth the length of the lawn.

D. Steer smoothly around obstacles, keeping wheel about 2 feet from any area you do not wish to treat. **CAUTION:** Exercise care around ornamental plants because weed controls can damage these plants.

Maintenance

A. Never leave leftover material in your spreader. Pour it back into the package and seal package tightly.

B. Wash spreader thoroughly after each use and allow it to dry completely before storing.
