



Models 1078, 1079 & 1081 Professional Cage Trap Instructions

- Baiting** Center bait in cage approximately 2 inches from back.
- Suggested Bait** For small animals such as groundhogs and rabbits use a fresh slice of apple. Squirrels and chipmunks are lured with peanut butter.
Raccoon baits include any fruit preserves spread on bread, or fish parts (fresh, canned or frozen).
- Setting** Lift door and set trigger by pulling finger through side of cage and pushing trigger rod forward.
- Lightest Trigger Release Setting** Place just tip of trigger rod under door cross rod (see Illustration 2).
- Heaviest Trigger Release Setting** Push end of trigger rod completely under door cross rod (see Illustration 3).
- Releasing Captured Animals** Set trap on end with door facing up. Push down outer door to be flush with inner door.
Insert supplied Trap Release Tool between doors and hook (see illustration 4).
Place trap on ground with handle side down. Door will open and animal will leave (see Illustration 5).
DO NOT ATTEMPT TO HANDLE CAPTURED ANIMALS
- NOTE:** Should you wish your Havahart Cage Trap doors to remain open, insert and hook Trap Release Tool (see illustration 6).

Please Note . . .

If you have difficulty setting your Havahart® live animal cage trap, it may be due to the Trigger Rod becoming "hung up" on the trap door.

To correct this problem, simply pull the long trigger rod forward until the circular portion of the Trigger Rod clears the door (see Illustration 7). Then, set the trap in the customary manner.

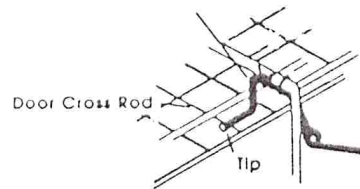
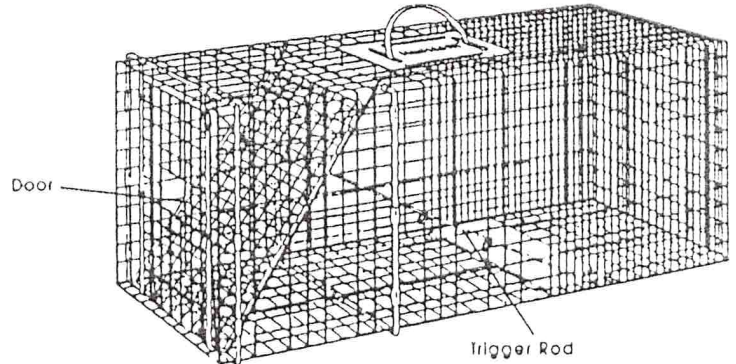

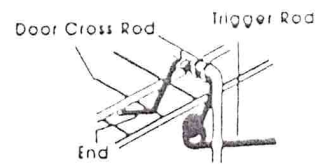

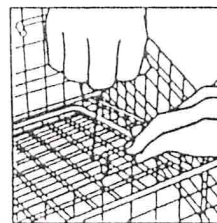

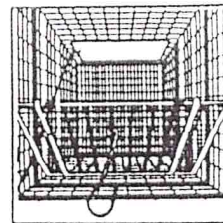
